


Reception Writing Workshop


What will we find out in this workshop?

We follow a fantastic handwriting scheme handwriting scheme called "Penpals" that teaches our children how to form their letters correctly.










Your Child's name writing journey





In the Autumn Term we work on letter formation and learning the letters of the alphabet to be able to write cvc (3 letter words)






Your Child's Writing

What will your child be expected to achieve by the end of Reception?

- Early Years Foundation Stage Curriculum 2021 Children at the expected level of development will:
- Write recognisable letters, most of which are correctly formed;
- Spell words by identifying sounds in them and representing the sounds with a letter or letters;
- Write simple phrases and sentences that can be ready by others.


Journey
